

Poultry Pairs

Print and cut out two or three copies of each sheet (depending on how many children will be playing the game). You may wish to laminate the pictures for durability.

Place all of the pictures face down. Players should take it in turns to choose two cards. If the cards chosen are a pair, i.e. a baby and adult of the same bird, they can keep the cards. If the cards are not a pair, they must be returned. The player who finishes with the most cards, is the winner.



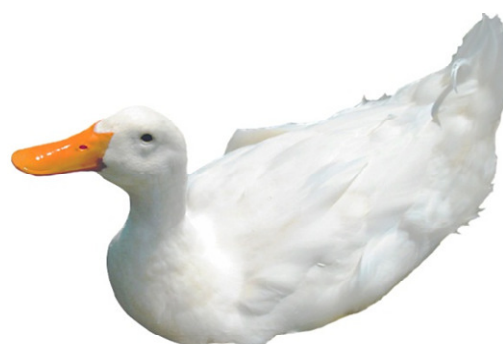

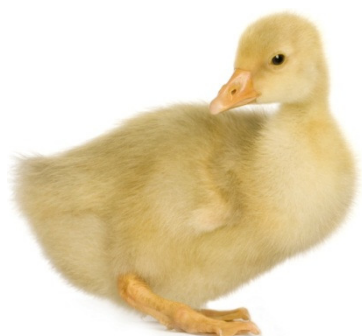
